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| Vaccination Status   | Definition by Country's Health Authority   | Test Requirements for passengers aged 5+   |
| Fully Vaccinated   | Received primary series of COVID-19 vaccines with final dose at least 14 days before embarkation.  | Testing not required. We recommend a COVID-19 test (Antigen or PCR) taken 3 days before departure. |
| Not fully Vaccinated   | Passengers can cruise unvaccinated (however, please inform yourself about the vaccination and testing requirements when flying into the respective country). | COVID-19 Antigen or PCR test is mandatory and needs to be taken within 3 days before departure.    |
| Kids under 5 years do not require pre-travel testing.  |  |  |

| Up to Date (Fully Vaccinated with at least one booster)   | Guests ages 18 or older must have received primary series of COVID-19 vaccines including one booster dose if eligible, received any time before embarkation. If cruise departs, arrives or visits Australia guests 12 to 17 years old must be fully vaccinated (no booster). | COVID-19 Antigen or PCR test needs to be taken within 3 days before departure.   |
| Not fully Vaccinated  | Vaccination and capacity restrictions apply. Guests aged 18 years or older who are not up to date require a vaccination exemption to sail. Guests 12 and older not fully vaccinated on cruises departing, arriving or visiting Australia require a medical exemption.        | COVID-19 Antigen or PCR test needs to be taken within 3 days before departure.   |
| Kids under 5 years do not require vaccination and pre-travel testing.   |  |  |
| <b>Attention:</b><br>* With the exception of sailings to or from Western Australia, vaccination requirements do not apply to children aged 11 years and under. For sailings to or from Western Australia, vaccination requirements do not apply to children aged 4 years and under. |  |  |

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| Vaccination Status  | Definition by Country's Health Authority  | Test Requirements for passengers aged 0+  |
| Fully Vaccinated (Passengers aged 12+)  | Received primary series of COVID-19 vaccines with final dose at least 14 days before embarkation. A booster is not required but strongly recommended.                                       | PCR test taken within 72 hours before boarding, Antigen test taken within 24 hours before boarding (antigen tests can be brought from home) |
| Not Fully Vaccinated (Passengers aged 12+)  | Vaccination and capacity restrictions apply. Guests aged 12 years or older who are not fully vaccinated require a medical exemption to sail. Please contact your Princess reservation team. | PCR test taken within 72 hours before boarding, Antigen test taken within 24 hours before boarding (antigen tests can be brought from home) |
| Not Fully Vaccinated (children aged 0-11*)  | Passengers are welcome to cruise.   | PCR test taken within 72 hours before boarding, Antigen test taken within 24 hours before boarding (antigen tests can be brought from home) |
